Our ultimate learning goal is to create a supportive academic ecosystem where errors are seen as learning opportunities and curiosity is always encouraged.

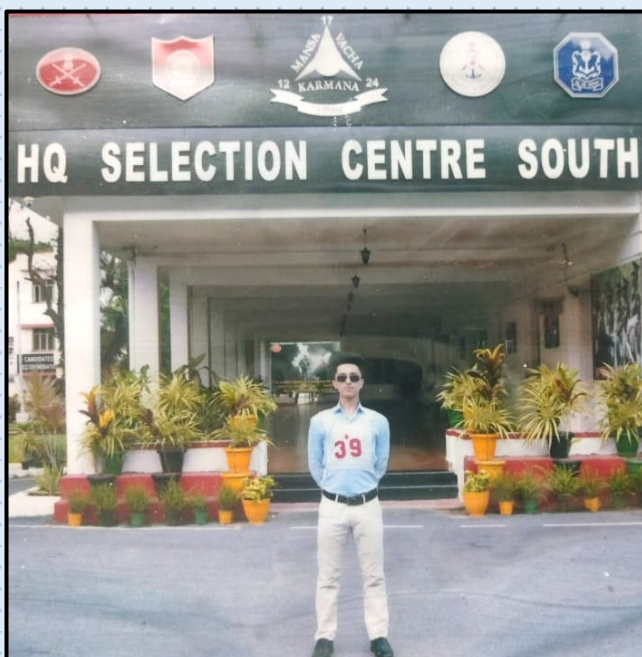
