
Ramdandees with opportunities to apply classroom knowledge, showcase creativity and gain confidence through practical learning.

National Mathematics Day Celebration – 22 December




National Mathematics Day was celebrated with great enthusiasm on 22 December to honour the birth anniversary of the legendary mathematician Srinivasa Ramanujan.

Ramdandees constructed the models using innovative and economical materials such as cardboard, thermocol, chart paper, LED lights, wires, switches, beads, sticks and recyclable items.

Before building the models, they studied formulas, rules, and applications, prepared layouts and then assembled the models through teamwork and careful planning. Working models helped visitors visually understand abstract concepts, while game-based exhibits created an atmosphere of joyful learning. The exhibition enabled Ramdandees to strengthen their knowledge of algebra, geometry, trigonometry, probability and number operations. More importantly, it helped them connect mathematics with everyday life, improve logical reasoning and develop analytical thinking. By explaining their models confidently, Ramdandees enhanced their communication skills and gained confidence. 




