ADMISSION PROCESS FAQ

1. Which classes are admissions offered for?

Admissions are offered for **Classes VI to X** (State Board).

- **Class VI** – Open admission
- **Classes VII to X** – Subject to availability of seats and merit
- **Class XI (Science Stream)** – Admission based on merit, aptitude test, and formation of a separate **NDA Preparation Batch**

2. Who conducts the admission process?

The admission process is conducted by **Bhonsala Military School**, functioning under the **Central Hindu Military Education Society (CHMES), Nashik**.

3. What are the components of the admission procedure?

The selection process includes:

1. **Written Examination**
2. **Physical Fitness Test**
3. **Medical Examination**
4. **Personal Interview**

All stages must be cleared to secure admission.

4. What subjects are included in the written exam?

For Class VI and XII:

- Subjects: English, Mathematics, Science and SST
- Based on the previous class curriculum.

5. Is the school fully residential?

Yes. **Bhonsala Military School is a fully residential school.**

Students must stay in the hostel throughout the academic year.

6. What is the medium of instruction?

The medium of instruction is **English**, with Marathi/Hindi taught as per board guidelines.

7. What board is the school affiliated to?

The school is affiliated to the **Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education (MSBSHSE)**.

8. When does the academic year start?

The academic year begins on **Second Monday of June** every year.

9. Does the school provide military training?

Yes. Students receive **military-style training**, including:

- Physical training
- Drill
- Weapon training (as per NCC norms)
- NCC Army/Navy/Air Wing enrolment
- Personality development for Defence Services
- Horse riding
- Swimming
- Obstacle course training

10. What documents are required during admission?

Common documents include:

- Birth Certificate
- Aadhaar Card
- Previous year's report card
- Transfer Certificate
- Medical fitness certificate
- Passport-size photographs
- Caste Certificate (if applicable)
- Aadhaar Cards of Parents and Guardians
- Xerox Copy of Bank Passbook (Joint Account with Student in **SBI**)

11. Is there any reservation policy?

Reservation is as per the **Government of Maharashtra norms** and **CHMES policies**.

12. How are hostel and mess facilities?

The school has disciplined residential facilities:

- Separate hostels for each class.
- Nutritious food through a regulated mess system
- Strict hygiene, safety, and discipline protocols

13. What physical standards are required?

Basic fitness is required, assessed through:

- Running
- Flexibility
- Endurance tests
- Medical examination for overall health

14. Is there an interview process?

Yes. After clearing written and physical tests, students attend a **Personal Interview** along with both parents conducted by the Admission Board to evaluate:

- Discipline
- Communication
- Interest in military training
- Overall personality
- Family details/profile.

15. How can parents track admission notifications?

Through:

- The **official school website**
- Official WhatsApp groups/helplines created during the admission cycle
- School Admission Office

16. Is there support for NDA aspirants?

Yes.

Class XI students entering the **Science Stream** undergo an **Aptitude Test**.

A special **NDA Preparation Batch** is formed based on merit, with:

- Dedicated academic plan
- Minimum holidays
- Physical and interview training

17. Does the school allow day scholars?

No. **Only residential students** are admitted.

18. Can admissions be cancelled mid-year?

Yes, in cases of:

- Lack of discipline
 - Poor attendance
 - Failure to meet academic/physical standards
 - Parent-requested withdrawal

19. What is the fee structure?

The fee structure is provided on the **school website, bms.bhonsala.in**, each year and may be revised (recommended 10% per year).
